# A Letter of Encouragement

We live in a world that is filled with discouraging news. Every newscast has some report about violence, conflict, disagreement, or updates about ongoing wars. From every corner of the world, we hear about the struggles and challenges faced by humanity. In regions engulfed by war, families are torn apart and entire communities are displaced. Political unrest and corruption plague many nations, leading to widespread protests and calls for reform. Natural disasters wreak havoc on both developed and developing countries alike, leaving destruction and despair in their wake. The news relates to things local to our area, things around the country, and news that spans the globe. It includes people of all ages, from young people perpetrating violent acts or those that find themselves as victims of those crimes, to the elderly whose lives are interrupted by floods, fires, extreme cold, and health issues. But that is not all that is happening in our world.

The purpose and plan of God continues as it has since the dawn of time, and the Bible gives us lots of encouragement to refocus our hearts and minds. In fact, the book of Act uses the word encouragement ten times. We first hear of Barnabas whose name means "son of encouragement." As the Word of God spreads in the early church, people are regularly encouraged. In Acts 13:15 the people in Antioch were asking Paul for some word of encouragement. What Paul replied with is worth our attention today, and I would encourage you to read what he had to say in the rest of Acts 13.

Even when Paul became a victim of violence and was left for dead after being stoned, he, and the other disciples with him, continued to preach the Gospel and said to encourage them "to continue in the faith, and saying that through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God." Acts 14:22 As the Gospel message spread, new believers would join in the task of sharing the good news about Jesus, like Apollos who continued to grow in his understanding of the Scriptures and become an early apologist for the truth of Christ in his day. And many other stories of encouragement can be found in the New Testament.

The various stories throughout the Bible have always been there to strengthen and encourage us. Paul says in Romans 15:4 "...whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope." I want to continue to encourage each of us to remain rooted and grounded in the Word of God so that we grow in its encouraging, hope giving power. And as Paul began his letter to the Romans, it is my hope and desire "that we may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine." (Rom. 1:12)

May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you(us) to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, that together you(we) may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 15:5-6


# Deacons Corner — FEBRUARY

Outreach Fund – The Outreach Fund is available to assist Carmel Reformed Church members participation in mission projects/trip by providing financial assistance for registration and travel expenses. This does not include normally scheduled JR/SR youth group trips. The fund will reimburse ½ of travel and registration costs up to \$500.00 per individual per calendar year. Christian Care – The Christian Care Fund is available to assist with financial needs for those who are encountering difficult circumstances and are struggling to cover their basic financial needs. Adoption Fund – For those considering an adoption please consider inquiring as to whether you will qualify for the Carmel Reformed Church Adoption Assistance Fund. All requests will require consistory approval.




# THE LOVE CYCLE

# What you do:

- 1. Draw a flower shape on paper and cut it out.
- 2. Place the flower template on felt and draw around it with the marker.
- 3. Cut out the felt flower. Then cut a small slit or hole through it.
- 4. Cut 8 inches of string. Thread it through the felt flower and tie to form a loop for hanging.
- 5. To the felt, add 3 to 5 drops of essential oil. This air freshener will last about 2 weeks.
- 6. Revive the scent, as needed, by adding a few drops of essential oil.
