

VAN PROJECT UPDATE



GEMS LITANY

Leader: In a world where we are being pressured to conform at every turn, from culture to social media, God calls us to live differently in Romans 12:2.

GEMS: Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is-his good, pleasing and perfect will (Romans 12:2).

ALL: Renew our hearts and minds, God. Transform us from the inside out and help us to live for You.

GEMS: *In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God* (John 1:1).

Leader: Lord, thank You for sending Jesus, the Word, to show us what You are like. You are with us, omnipotent, righteous, and directing us. You are the foundation of our faith and the source of all Truth. Help us to trust Your Word, the Bible, as the standard for Truth.

ALL: God, we cannot live transformed on our own. Please equip us by Your Spirit to live differently than the world. Help us to know Your good, pleasing, and perfect will.

GEMS: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! (2 Corinthians 5:17)

Leader: Lord, because of what Jesus has done on the cross and in His resurrection, we can be forgiven for our sins and have a right relationship with You. When we trust You as Lord and Savior, You make us new. Transform us from the inside out, and may we shine Your love and Truth in the world.

GEMS: All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work (2 Timothy 3:16-17).

Leader: Lord, equip us to live as Your people, boldly sharing the Truth of scripture with others. Help us to remember Your Word is the most powerful tool.

ALL: God, please help us to live out the Truth of scripture and to walk in obedience to You.

GEMS: *Then you will know truth, and the truth will set you free* (John 8:32).

Leader: Father, Your Word set us free from the lies of the world. May we always stand firm on scripture as the ultimate standard of Truth.

ALL: Transform us from the inside out through Your Word and renew our minds.

GEMS: Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says (James 1:22).

Leader: Lord, help us not only to hear Your Word but to live it out daily in our actions and choices.

GEMS: Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age (Matthew 28:19-20).

Leader: You call each of us to show Your love and to tell the good news of Jesus Christ so that others may come to know Him. We need Your help to carry out this mission. Strengthen us, Lord, so we can show and tell the gospel message that transform lives. Make us bold messengers of the hope that we have in You.

ALL: We commit to living as Your transformed people, shining your light in the world.

GEMS: And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God (Micah 6:8).

Leader: Together, and with Your help and guidance, Lord, we embrace Your call to act justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with You.
